Code of Conduct

To attend face to face, virtual or online programs that are held by A Slice of Life, all participants must agree to follow our code of conduct.

Payment of course fees is an acknowledgement of your understanding and agreement. Failure to comply may result in you not being able to continue in the course you're enrolled in. Course fees will not be refunded if this is the case.

All attendees of courses held by A Slice of Life agree to:

- Arrive on time and be ready to participate.
- Be clean, neat and tidy, wearing deodorant, with your teeth brushed and clean clothes. If you're attending a cooking class or a shared meal, your hands and fingernails must also be clean and you must be wearing closed in shoes.
- Be respectful of tutors and fellow participants. Bullying, intimidation, rude language and behaviour that is considered to be excluding or inappropriate will not be tolerated.
- Friendships are encouraged, but to ensure that everyone is comfortable with contact outside of class, all exchanges of personal information must go through your tutor. If you want someone's phone number, email address, Snapchat, Instagram or Facebook details, please ask your tutor to ask on your behalf. Please be respectful if the other person doesn't want to exchange details.
- Advise your tutor if you are unwell or if you're injured on your way to the program or during the program.
- Advise the tutor if you have concerns over attending the program for any reason.
- Tell us what you love about the program and what you think can be improved.
